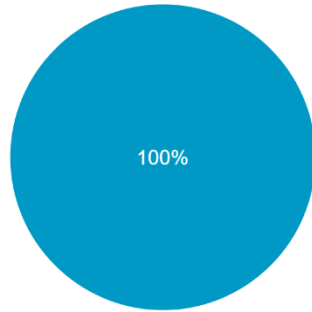

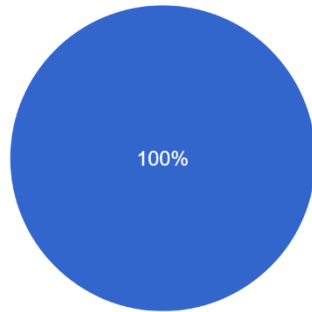

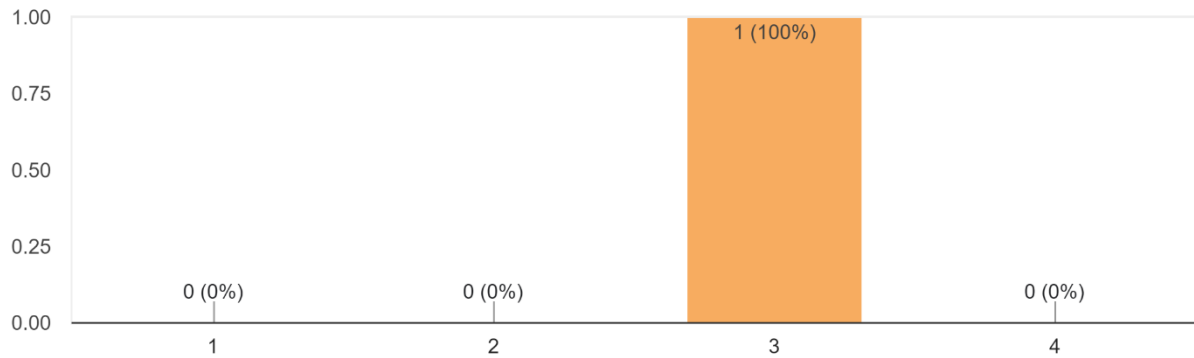

Rate the Effectiveness of Goal #1: District shall prepare students to be college and/or career ready upon completion of high school

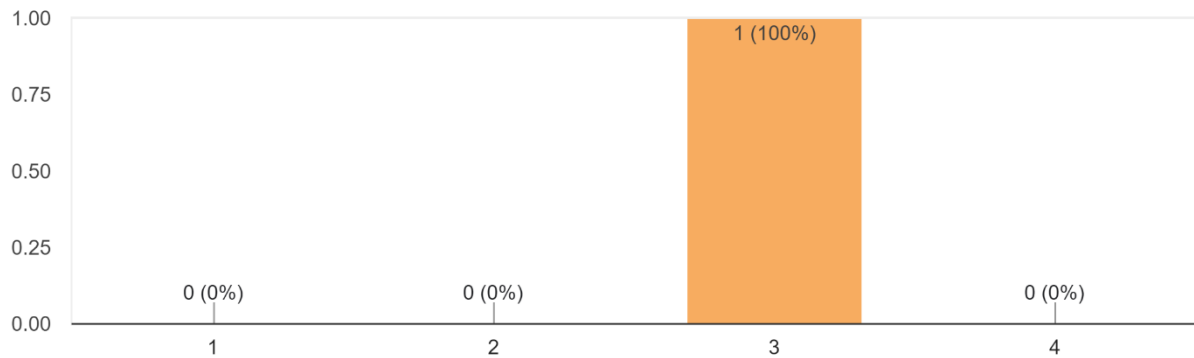

Rate the Effectiveness of Goal #2: Teachers in the District shall be fully credentialed and provided professional development on the implementation of academic content and performance standards.

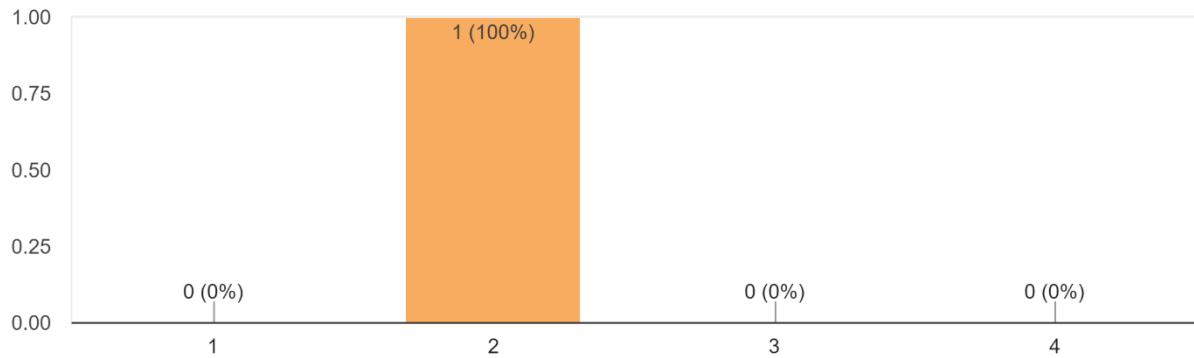

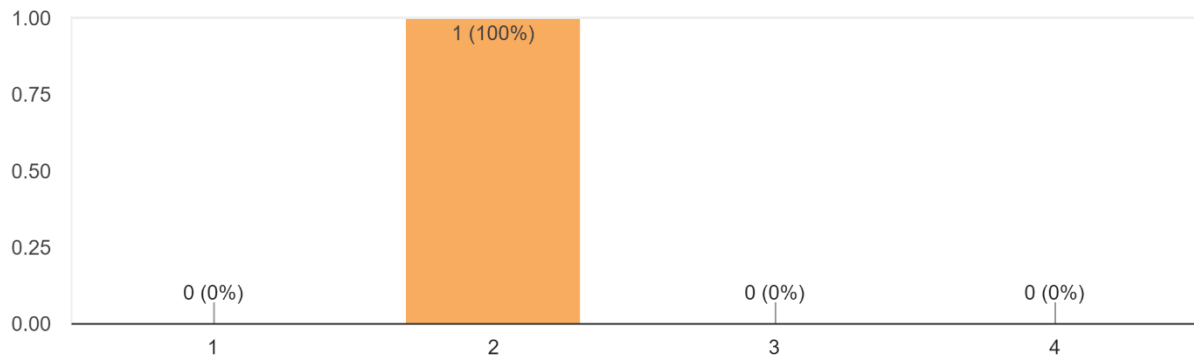

Rate the Effectiveness of Goal #4: The District shall implement a multi-tiered system of support for English learners, homeless youth, students with disabilities and foster youth.

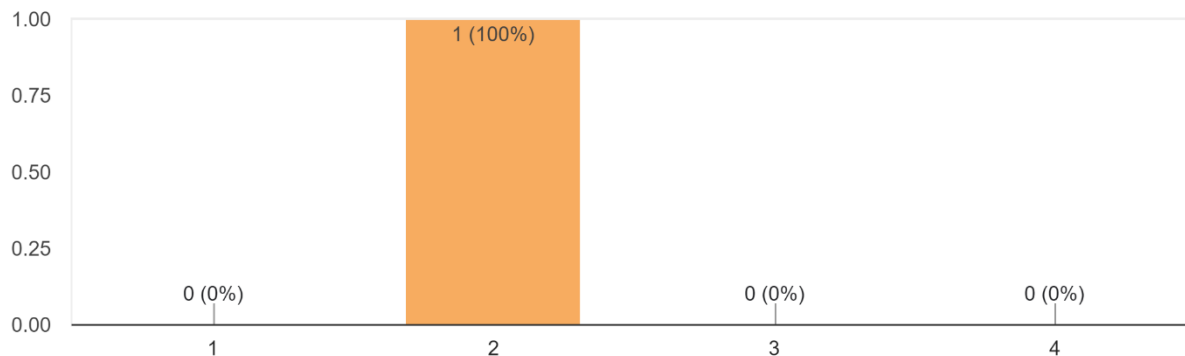

Rate the Effectiveness of Goal #5: All school facilities shall be well maintained to help create an environment conducive to achievement and learning.

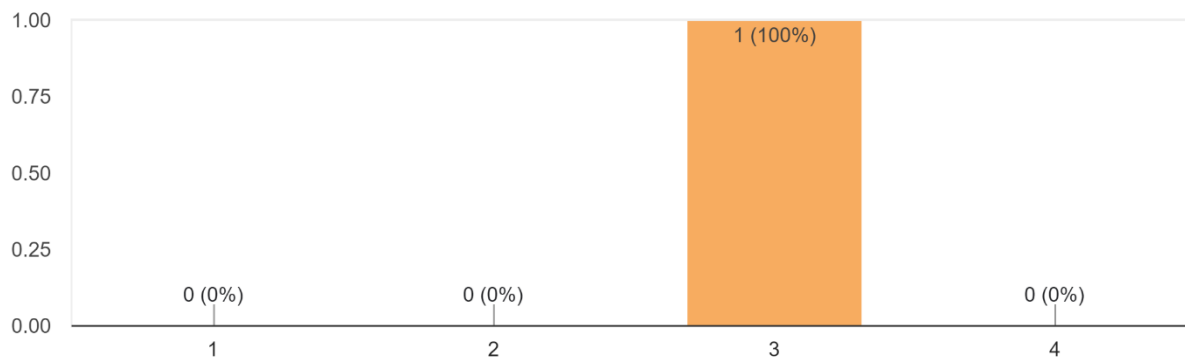

What progress of the District are you most proud of and how do you recommend the District plan to maintain or build upon that success?

Graduation rate is high. The District offers a good range of CTE courses. The District provides PD opportunities for teachers. The District and Board have more respect and appreciation of classified staff. Recommendations: Continue to expand CTE course offerings. Establish articulation and dual enrollment opportunities with regional colleges. Establish more internships for CTE pathway completers. Continue to include classified staff in district-wide committees.

What steps do you recommend the District take to address areas of low performance and performance gaps for different student groups?

Early intervention for student concerns so they know someone cares. Provide students with a choice of discipline (not suspension). Reward students for positive behavior. Provide district-led classified professional development opportunities. Increase the working hours for Paras and Health Techs so they can spend more time with students outside the classroom, and before/after school hours. Have a Maintenance/Custodian position during the daytime at each school site, especially the higher populated sites. Base the number of Custodians at each site on the activities/events rather than student count as sites with more events stretch employees further resulting in them working harder and under more pressure. More Cafeteria Workers and food stations so ALL students receive a meal and have time to consume; not just stand in line for 30 minutes. Offer CTE program Tours for "at risk" and special population incoming 9th-grade students.
