G. EDUCATIONAL SERVICES – ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. El Dorado Union High School District 2023 Advanced Placement Results.

Deputy Superintendent Moore stated that Advanced Placement (AP) exams are proctored annually. District Administration commends AP teachers for their effective teaching practices and the students' efforts to master the course content. Introducing students to the rigor of AP courses boosts college success. Students who complete their first AP course are 3 percentage points more likely to graduate from college within four years. Students taking an AP Exam and scoring 3 or higher are 6 percentage points more likely to graduate from college within four years and 8 percentage points more likely if they score 3 or higher on two AP Exams. These gains are consistent among under-represented minority, first-generation, and lower-achieving students.
