Services. During the year, School Safety Committee Meetings are held with school safety personnel and law enforcement agencies to discuss school and community safety strategies within our County and State.

Mr. Palmer advised that the plans have been reviewed several times this year and have been updated. This is a fluid document and it's going to change continuously. District staff attend workshops to learn about different things we can consider and implement.
