updated budget and subsequent year projections to reflect the ongoing implementation of the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), the formula rolled the revenue limit and numerous grants into one funding model. Based on the California State Adopted 2023/24 budget and other projections. He reviewed the District's revenue, enrollment, other factors, expenditures, and reserves.

Assistant Superintendent Robert Whittenberg stated that the District currently has sufficient projected resources and reserves to maintain a positive fund balance through the end of the 2025/26 fiscal year. The District will continue to review programs and expenditures in order to maintain fiscal viability in the future.
