G. EDUCATIONAL SERVICES - ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. El Dorado Union High School District 2024 Advanced Placement Results. Advanced Placement (AP) exams are proctored annually. District Administration commends AP teachers for their effective teaching practices and the students' efforts to master the course content. Introducing students to the rigor of AP courses boosts college success. Students who complete their first AP course are 3 percentage points more likely to graduate from college within four years. Students taking an AP Exam and scoring 3 or higher are 6 percentage points more likely to graduate from college within four years and 8 percentage points more likely if they score 3 or higher on two AP Exams. These gains are consistent among under-represented minority, first-generation, and lower-achieving students.

J. HUMAN RESOURCES - ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Approval of Variable Term Waiver application for Elizabeth Bloxsom - UMHS Agriculture Teacher. The Administration is requesting approval to submit a *Variable Term Waiver Request*. This waiver will allow for the hiring of part-time agricultural teacher at Union Mine High School. An open recruitment for this assignment resulted in no candidates with the appropriate credential authorization, however, Ms. Bloxsom's background and post-secondary preparation made her a top candidate. This waiver will permit Ms. Bloxsom to work during the 2024-2025 school year while she completes additional coursework in her credential program which will make her internship eligible. The assignment will be 2 periods (Ag Mechanics and Advanced Ag mechanics) in the Fall Term and 2 periods (Ag Mechanics and Animal Science) in the Spring Term (grades 9 – 12).

Ms. Bloxsom holds a BA in Public Health from University of Nevada, Reno and has more than 4 years of prior experience in the Agriculture setting, including an intensive Ag Mechanics training in Summer 2024. She is currently beginning the credentialing process, has passed the CBEST and portions of the Agriculture CSET and will take the remaining tests in Fall 2024.

The Administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the submittal of the *Variable Term Waiver Request* to the CTC on behalf of Elizabeth Bloxsom.
